



Who: Clients need identification for all household members and proof of residency of Marathon County. The amount of food received depends upon the number of people living in the household. A household may use Food Pantry every 21 days. Clients must show: Photo ID & Social Security Card, Proof of address, proof of income (last 30 days)

What: Our food pantry is unique because clients are able to shop the pantry and pick out the items they would like from each food group. This gives individuals the freedom to choose what they need.

Bread and Produce Distribution

Helps families with fresh produce, bread, or other items when available. These items could include meat, milk, dairy products, etc. This service may be accessed daily (Monday through Friday) as supplies last. There is no limit at this time to the number of days a week individuals may come in, as what is available varies depending upon donations received. A limit of one visit per day, however, is enforced.

*These items are available Monday through Friday, from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. as supplies last..

Where: 202 Callon Street, Wausau- Wisconsin (Use Callon Street door)

When: Our **Food Pantry** is open Monday- Friday 10:30a-2:30p. Clients can use the food pantry one time within a 3-week period.

*Carry-out lunch is served Monday through Friday from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. to anyone in the community needing a nutritious meal.

Additional Information: The pantry is stocked with donations from food drives, businesses, and individuals.
